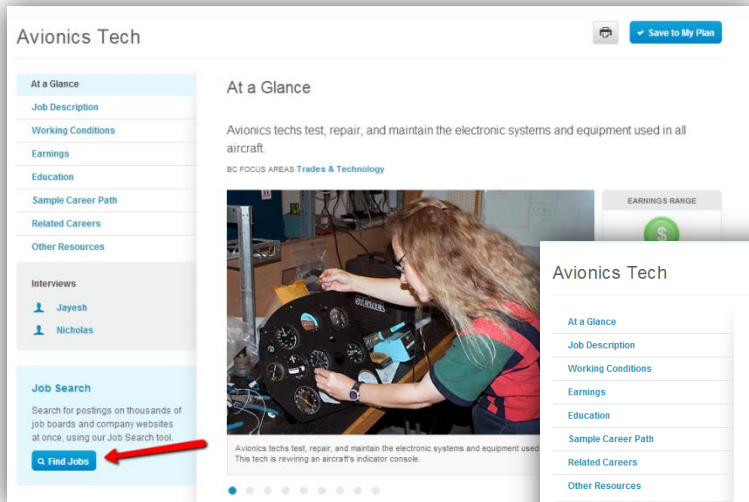

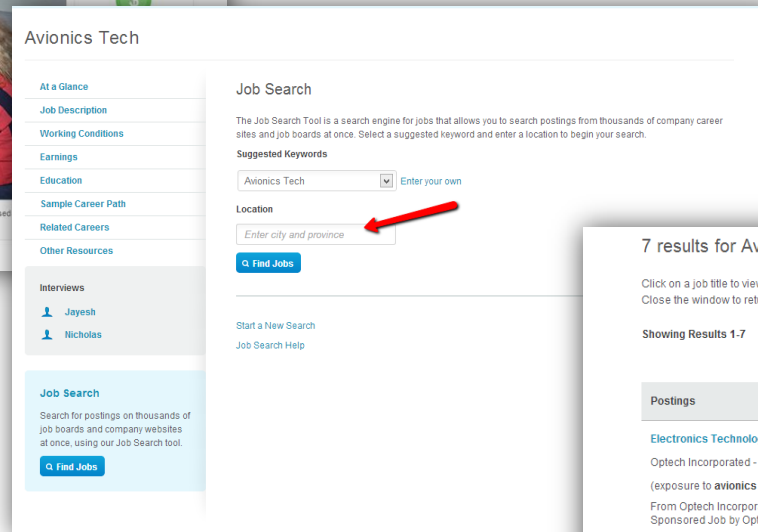

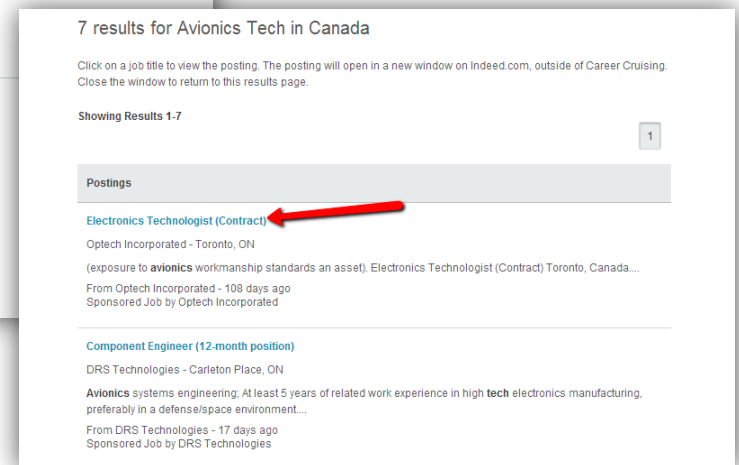

In order to work as a geologist, you must have at least a bachelor's degree in geology or a related subject. However, many job applicants also have a master's degree or PhD in geology.

A master's degree is usually the minimum requirement for entry-level research positions in private industry and government agencies. A PhD is necessary for most high-level research positions and to teach geology in universities or colleges. It usually takes 1 to 2 years to earn a master's degree, and 4 to 5 years to complete a PhD.

At the undergraduate level, students are introduced to a core group of subjects that all include mineralogy, petrology, paleontology, stratigraphy, and structural geology. As the study becomes more complex and can include subjects such as geomorphology, crystallography, and sedimentology.

In some provinces and territories, geologists must register with a professional association independently. The requirements for registration may include completing a certain amount of work as a geologist and passing a formal exam. Contact your province or territory for more information.
