





Education & Training

In order to work as a geologist, you must have at least a bachelor's degree in geology or a related subject. However, many job applicants also have a master's degree or PhD in geology.

A master's degree is usually the minimum requirement for entry-level research positions in private industry and government agencies. A PhD is necessary for most high-level research positions and to teach geology in colleges. It usually takes 1 to 2 years to earn a master's degree, and 4 to 5 years to complete a PhD.

At the undergraduate level, students are introduced to a core group of subjects that all geologists study, including mineralogy, petrology, paleontology, stratigraphy, and structural geology. At the graduate level, students become more specialized in their study and can include subjects such as geomorphology, crystallography, and sedimentology.

Many states require geologists to be licensed to practice. Depending on the state you are in, you may need to pass a formal exam and complete several years of work experience as a geologist. Contact your state's licensing agency for more information.
