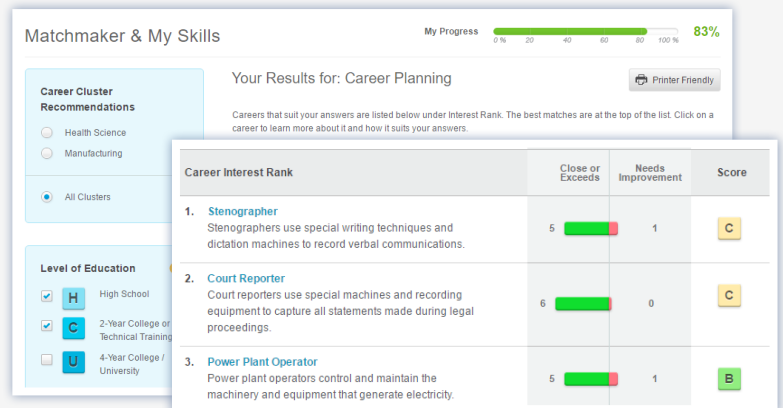

BUILD SELF-AWARENESS

Thousands of career options exist in today's job market, many of which students don't know about, all of which require a different educational pathway. Choosing a direction for the future begins with students better understanding their individual strengths and interests. Career Cruising for K-12 helps them do that from the beginning through four in-depth assessments:

CAREER MATCHMAKER ASSESSMENT

Students begin with Career Matchmaker, where they answer questions about their likes and dislikes. Once answers are complete, students are shown a list of ranked career suggestions to help inform the direction they'll be successful pursuing. They can also view recommended career clusters and filter suggestions by level of education needed.



MY SKILLS ASSESSMENT

Knowing how to find the fault, repair or replace the damaged part and put everything back together again. People are more likely to enjoy a career they're good at *and* one that matches their interests. The My Skills assessment asks students to rate their skill level in 45 key areas to see how these skills match up with their careers of interest. Answers range from "I don't have this skill" to "I am highly skilled."

LEARNING STYLES INVENTORY

The Learning Styles Inventory helps students understand how they learn. The assessment analyzes preferences and tendencies according to three learning methods: visual, auditory, and tactile. When a student understands their learning style, it improves their ability to study and, in turn, their likelihood for success.
