Topic 1) Review/Refresher: Students Perspective & School Administration System

Topic 3) School SSP Administration System

This webinar session will be dedicated to the School SSP Administration System. Topics covered include:

- Viewing, exporting, and printing reports for your school
- Accessing user's guides, classroom activities, and other teaching resources
